

## Overview of the EVHOP Internship Program:

The East Valley House of Prayer Internship Program exists to see this generation praying the heart of God, growing in the knowledge of God, and ministering the love of God. EVHOP Interns will experience a lifestyle model of PRAY, GROW, & MINISTER.

### **PRAY:**

EVHOP interns dedicate themselves to seeking the heart of God in the place of prayer, ministering to the Lord in the place of prayer, & interceding for others in the place of prayer. Interns engage in the following:

- **Sacred Trust** – You are committing to keep a "Sacred Trust" of a minimum of 10 hours of prayer (in the EVHOP prayer room) each week. These are hours that you are not in the position of leading the gathering.
- **Leading Prayer** – This program is designed to develop prayer leaders and so during the course of your program, you will be asked to lead prayer meetings.
- **Corporate Intercession** – Interns will attend no less than 3 corporate prayer gatherings each week at EVHOP.

### **GROW:**

Like Jesus, we are called to grow in wisdom and power in the Lord. Therefore, EVHOP interns will engage in intentional discipleship, study, and mentorship.

- **Online Classes** – Take 2 online / video classes assigned by the EVHOP Director. Present homework and papers to EVHOP leadership.
- **Cohort Groups** - Participate on a weekly basis with your group in book studies and discussion; be prepared to present ministry updates and study reviews.
- **Personal Mentorship** – Meet on a weekly basis with your personal mentor to discuss intern activities, studies, and personal discipleship & heart issues.

### **MINISTER:**

Life in Christ is designed to be shared. We are being filled so that we can pour out the love, power, and presence of the Father to others. We are called to love others. With this in mind, EVHOP interns will commit to at least two of the following areas of ministry during their internship.

- **Worship** – Participating with worship teams and/or leading worship sets during EVHOP prayer gatherings.
- **Works of Justice & Service** – Options include: engaging with one or more pro-life ministries (Bound4Life, CPC, Voices for the Voiceless); serving the local church; supporting regional prayer conferences, and partnering with local ministries such as Eleven11, Love ASU, and BridgeBuilders. EVHOP is also actively investigating other areas of outreach and justice for engagement.
- **Children & Youth** – Help coordinate and lead EVHOP youth events. Interface with Eleven11 ministry. Help develop and implement children and youth programs for EVHOP and the local church. Establishing and growing high school campus prayer groups.
- **Evangelism** – Taking prayer and the love of Jesus into the community through regular prayer evangelism outings and various other evangelism events sanctioned by EVHOP.
