Relationships & Discipleship Prayer Focus Scriptures — 02.07.2024

Pray for revelation of Jesus' glory, our hope in Him, His reward in us and those who yet will be His, and His power.

¹⁷That the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, ¹⁸the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may KNOW [experience] what is the hope of His calling [assurance/clarity of God's call for our life], what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints [our destiny as Jesus' inheritance], ¹⁹and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power... (Eph. 1:17-19)

Pray for growth in the love of God in Christ and love towards one another.

⁹ And this I pray, that your love may abound still more and more in knowledge and all discernment, 10 that you may approve the things that are excellent, that you may be sincere and without offense till the day of Christ, 11 being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God. (Philippians 1:9-11)

Pray for us to grow in loving discipleship relationships with others that portray the glory of God in Christ.

³⁴ A new commandment I give to you, that you <u>love one another; as I have loved you</u>, that you also love one another. ³⁵ <u>By this all will know that you are My disciples</u>, if you have love for one another."(John 13:34-35)

Pray for grace to abide in the love of God in Christ, living from a place of fellowship with His Spirit.

⁴ Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you <u>abide in Me</u>. ⁵ "I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for <u>without Me you can do nothing</u>...⁸ By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples. ⁹ "As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; <u>abide in My love</u>. (John 15:4-5, 8-9)

For revelation of the authority and power of Christ that propels us into confident obedience to the Great Commission.

¹⁸ And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority [power] has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. ¹⁹ <u>Go therefore and make disciples</u> of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ <u>teaching them</u> to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

Pray for unity with one another in Christ that glorifies God.

⁵ May the God of patience and comfort grant you to be like-minded toward one another... ⁶ that you may with one mind and one mouth glorify the...Father... ¹³ May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. (Rom. 15:5-6, 13)

Pray to know God's will and to be fruitful in ministry and strengthened by intimacy with Him.

⁹ That you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; ¹⁰that you may have a walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; ¹¹strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy... (Col. 1:9-11)
